

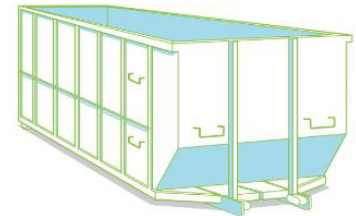


# RENTING YOUR DUMPSTER
